Celebrating its 40th year, the Hong Kong Arts Centre (HKAC) presents *Wan Chai Grammatica: Past, Present, Future Tense*, an exhibition that explores Hong Kong's cultural and artistic identity as seen through the lens of one of Hong Kong's most iconic city districts, Wan Chai. Held at Pao Galleries, the exhibition examines the role of the Wan Chai neighbourhood in forming Hong Kong's unique artistic identity and its image in the eyes of both local and international audiences. During the exhibition period, thematic tours narrating the history of the area, as well as art experience workshops, are available for audiences to learn more about its history as well as the district's connections with each piece of artwork.
