This first solo exhibition by Hong Kong-based artist duo Zheng Mahler is inspired by philosopher Thomas Nagel's 1974 essay *What is it like to be a bat?*, and showcases new works and video installations, one of which shows the viewer transforming, from a first-person perspective, from a human into a bat to journey around Mui Wo.

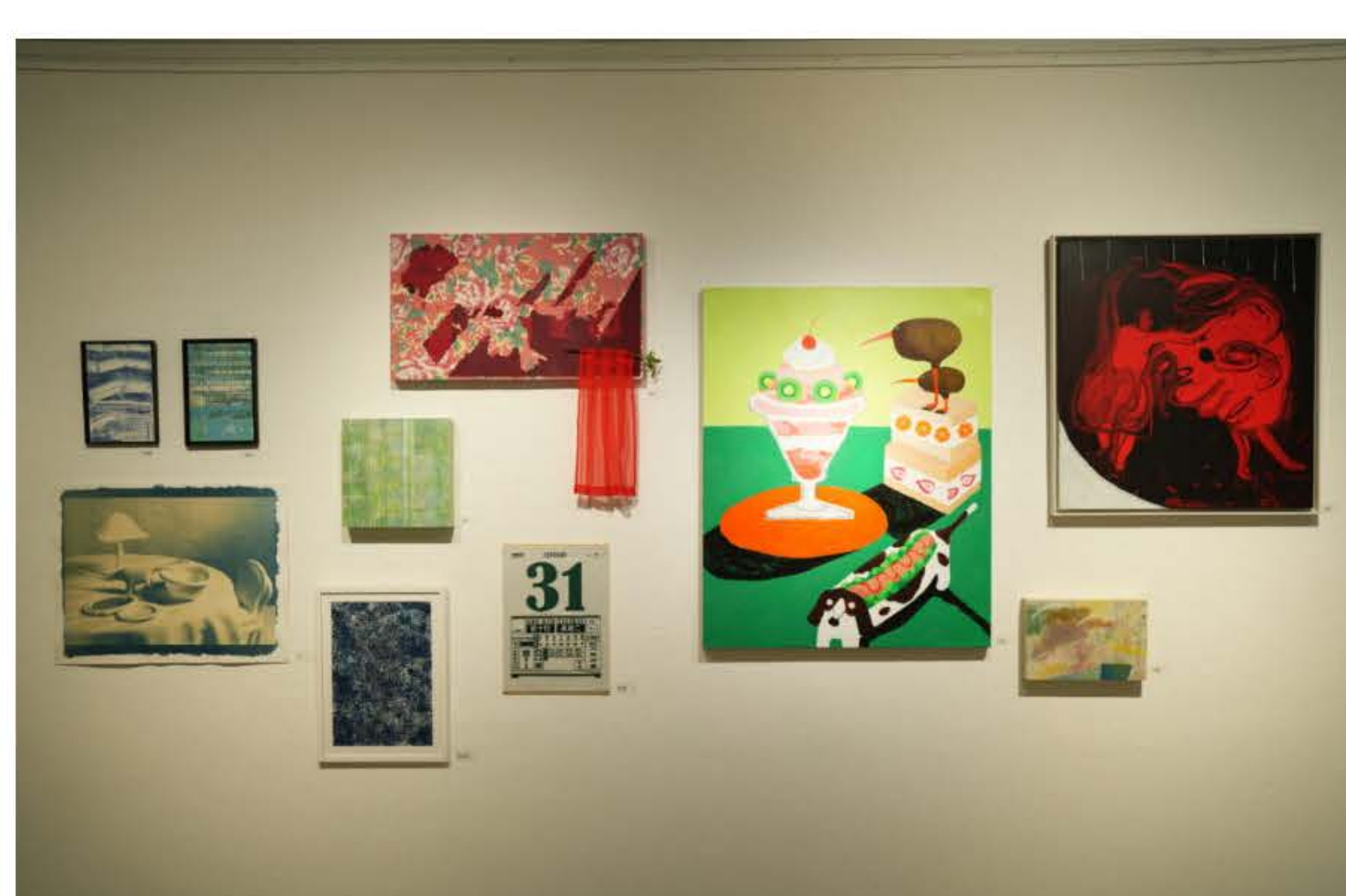
