- Tertiary education in any discipline (Fresh graduate and current students are most welcomed)
- Interested in arts, familiar with the local art scenes or relevant experience in art-related field will be an advantage
- Good communication skills in Cantonese, Mandarin and English
- Proactive and have strong sense of responsibility
