








Respondents

Findings 1 - Popular Destinations

Among the 11 places picked out for the interview, the most popular destinations are:


Most popular places	Purpose of visiting
Olympian City 奥海城	Shopping/Dining/Transportation
Tai Kok Tsui Municipal Services Building 大角咀市政大廈	Grocery Shopping
Fu Tor Loy Shopping Centre 富多來商場	Dining
Others: Mong Kok 其他: 旺角	Shopping/Transportation

Findings 2 - Pedestrian Circulation Pattern

- 1. Pedestrian traffic flow mainly from West to East/South (orange arrow):
 - South toward 奧海城
 - East toward 旺角
- 2. Commonly travelled road/streets (Red line):
 - 大角咀道
 - 埃華街
 - 福全街
 - 晏架街




Findings 3 - Pedestrian Walking Habit

Pedestrians tend to skip the inner streets, mainly because...

- 1) No major destination within inner streets
- 2) Narrow pavements
- 3) Street obstruction
- 4) Traffic & safety concerns
- 5) No public transportation stops

Findings 4 - Important Considerations for Choosing Walking Route

The <u>TOP 3</u> considerations are...

- Fastest route that saves time & without the need for detours
- Greeneries along the way with clean environment
- Pedestrian safety

While they are less concerned about...

- Less traffic lights
- Not crowded, no need to walk onto the road
- Sitting-out areas or open spaces along the route

Some other considerations suggested by the interviewees...

- Pet facilities
- Smell
- Elderly-friendly facilities

























Findings 5 - Major Sentiments/Experience Shared

1. Environmental hygiene/street cleanliness problems

For example:

- Waste & miscellaneous articles on the roadside
- Dog fouling
- Water dripping from buildings



- ▲ 「街道有很多雜物,環境不太整潔」
- ▲ 「經過橫街時感覺**污糟**,見到垃圾堆積、有老鼠出沒」
- 🚢 「有冷氣機**滴水**,又有**狗糞**問題」
- ▲ 「有幾次黃昏和夜晚,都見過一堆**老鼠**在街邊成群結伴,有時清晨散步亦會見到老鼠屍體」



Findings 5 - Major Sentiments/Experience shared

2. Pedestrian safety concerns

- Many hardware stores and vehicle maintenance workshops located in the inner streets
- Double parking, loading/unloading of lorries, etc.
- Causing safety issues



- ▲「很多工廠大廈**車很多**,特別是橡樹街, 唯有 周圍看看有沒有車,腳不太好行得多就唔爭 氣」
- ▲「很多車及大貨車,有時會**看不清楚**交通狀況, 我會**繞道**而行」
- ▲「體驗很一般,貨車經常上落貨阻街,我又要 **推著買餸車行**」
- ▲「附近多五金鋼材店,容易碰撞,又多車」



Findings 5 - Major Sentiments/Experience shared

3. Busy traffic & pedestrian volume

- Heavy flow of people in the area
- Inconvenience for wheelchair users/elderly/children



- ▲ 「覺得十分擁擠:因大角咀有很多人使用**輪椅** 或**推車仔**,不時也會與行人發生**碰撞** 」
- ▲「街道太多人,太擠迫,人與人之間空間太少, 例如有人沒有戴口罩咳嗽,會感很煩躁、厭惡」
- ▲「小朋友要帶著興趣班的物品很辛苦,街上的人又不讓人」



Findings 5 - Major Sentiments/Experience shared

4. Traffic arrangement

- Long waiting time for traffic light: e.g. 福全街 (with low traffic flow)
- Some found it disorganized



- ▲ 「福全街**新建燈位**:車輛不多,行人**要等**待時間變長,反而影響了步行體驗」
- ▲ 「福全街燈位無車,不需要有燈位」
- ▲ 「交通太繁忙,車輛太多,**交通燈號**及安排需 改善」
- ▲ 「大角咀有很多小街道/小巷 · 也會有很多車, 但小街道/小巷大多沒有斑馬線或交通燈」
- ▲ 「**櫸樹街往新九龍廣場路口**要改善行人過路安排及交通燈口」
